

Lincoln builder chosen to build pioneer affordable housing

A Lincoln homebuilder has been chosen to build a one-of-a-kind home in Omaha.

Brighton Construction will build the first-ever “concept home” through the Partnership for Advancing Technology in Housing, a public-private arm of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The partnership describes the concept home as a “home of the future” with flexible floor plans that can change as the owner’s life changes and with new technologies and production efficiencies to make homebuilding more affordable.

The partnership intends the house to become a national model for affordable homebuilding and hopes it will be a model for rebuilding the areas of the Gulf Coast destroyed by Hurricane Katrina
