Energy Efficiency is Highly Cost Effective

A number of recent studies that look at spending and savings across energy efficiency programs in several states are all showing the same thing....energy efficiency efforts are highly cost effective. In other words, by investing in these programs, states are able to meet electrical demand at a lower cost than if new power was generated. ACEEE recently released two new fact sheets, one illustrating that energy efficiency is consistently the lowest-cost option for meeting demand, and the other showing that investing in these programs can lower the cost of the Clean Power Plan, which provides extra incentives to increase efficiency efforts.
