This continues to show Maryland's commitment to improving energy consumption and reducing costs in the state's homes and buildings.

The US Department of Energy recently released a report on the impact of Building Codes that shows a significant savings opportunity for US home and building owners as a result of model energy codes. Highlights include savings projections of....

- \$126 billion energy cost savings
- 841 MMT of avoided CO2 emissions
- 12.82 quads of primary energy

Which equates to....

- 177 million passenger vehicles
- 245 coal power plants
- 89 million homes
